



Appendix 1- Home Match- Information for WHC

- Please make sure that you have read and are familiar with the WHC risk assessments
- Please can you ensure that you complete an attendance register for your team, this must include all subs, coaches and any WHC umpires.
- The visiting team are responsible for their own attendance registers, although please encourage visiting teams to use the NHS Covid-19 App
- The changing rooms and showers are not in use. Please arrange playing colours in advance and arrive changed for the game.
- Toilet facilities are available with social distancing rules needing to be adhered to. Only 1 person is allowed in the toilet area at one time.
- Players should arrive with full water bottles, and if possible a spare to save them having to enter the clubhouse for water.
- Do not congregate in the clubhouse on arrival for your game - stay outside whenever possible please ensure that at all times when you are off the pitch you must remain in socially distanced groups of no more than 6 people. This includes post and pre-match team talks, Warm-ups, and Cool downs.
- The clubhouse will be open at times but please ensure that you follow the rules in place at the current time. The track and trace system remains in place for anyone using the facilities other than for toilets.
- Anyone visiting from another club can only access the clubhouse to use the toilets. In exceptional circumstances the clubhouse can also be used for first aid purposes.
- Players, coaches, umpires, and any spectators should bring their own hand sanitiser and face masks
- There is a "one-way" for access onto and from the pitch:
 - Far Pitch. Please enter via the usual gate but leave via the double gates at the far side of the pitch
 - Near Pitch. Please enter via the usual gate but leave via the double gates nearest the clubhouse.



- Please ensure that you start the matches on time and leave the pitch promptly at the end of the game.
- Cool down/stretching should be done outside of the pitch.
- Spectators are welcome but are to remain outside of the pitch area and adhere to the current social distancing guidelines.
- All players, officials, volunteers, and spectators should undergo a self-assessment for any Covid-19- symptoms prior to arrival at Woking HC in accordance with the EH Guidelines. Anyone displaying symptoms for Covid-19 should remain at home and follow the NHS guidelines on self-isolation and testing.
