Welcome to Woking Hockey Club Juniors Newsletter.

GOALS & VISION

NEW JUNIOR PROGRAMME (additional costs are highlighted)

SEPTEMBER COACHING THEME

BACK TO BASICS

Holding the stick: Basic, double V, long handle, left and right hand only

Movement skills: Change pace & direction, lateral movement, turn all directions quickly, fast

footwork, reaction times, peripheral vision

Moving with the ball: Open stick dribble, Indian dribble

Passing: Push, sweep hit, slap (split grip hit)

Goal Scoring: As passing, rebounds

Receiving: Open stick from the front, open stick from left and right, reverse stick from the front,

reverse from left and right
